Although, the foundation and clothing closet is located in Evansville, it serves families and children throughout the tri-state. Borrowed Hearts has expanded and has a location in Terre Haute, Jasper and Owensboro. Our goal is that every foster family in Indiana will have access to services like ours within the next 5 years. In addition to the clothing and hygiene bank, we offer a monthly support group, meal program and host a back to school event.

Since we opened our doors in 2016, we have served 4,610 children!! The need is enormous and continues to grow. Without our generous sponsors and fundraising, the Borrowed Hearts Foundation will not be able to meet the growing needs of these children.
